SALT it up!

Objective:

To engage conversations with people in public places where 2-3 teenagers can use short videos to start gospel conversations using the "Then What" SALT clip found at www.somethingamazing.net/then-what

What you Need:

A fully charged smart phone with internet capability (one for every 2-3 teens in your group), Life in 6 Words GOSPEL cards, and a heart dependent on God through prayer.


What to say:

"Hi my name is _____ and this is (intro others). We are from _____ (your city/state) attending a Dare 2 Share conference with thousands of other teenagers. We are showing people short 90 second videos around big life questions. May we show you one and hear how you would answer this question?" (If they say no, then ask them if you can share with them the most important message in the world. If they say yes then show them the video.)

Afterward, say, "Okay, tell us what you think happens after you die?" Listen to them and then ask, "Would it be good news to you if you could know for sure that you were going to heaven when you die?"

If they say "yes," share the GOSPEL with them. If they say "no" try to find out why. If they are not interested, encourage them to watch the video at www.lifein6words.com or download the Life in 6 Words app. If they are ready to trust in Jesus, walk them through the process, and then try to recommend a church in the area and e-mail them Dare 2 Share's follow up PDF "Now Grow!"

Remember to **ask** questions (and listen deeply), **admire** what you can about what they believe (find common ground) and **admit** the reason you're a Christian is that you were desperate for someone to save you.



Don't forget that the goal is a gospel conversation, not just an evangelical presentation.
