## Q & A for Lead THE Cause

1. Who can earn college credit by participating in any Dare 2 Share's Lead THE Cause events?
  - a. High school, gap year or college students.
2. How would these three CCU college credits for YTM 197 Lead THE Cause - Evangelism Training transfer?
  - a. Each student should contact their college of interest and find out how these three special topic credits of evangelism training would transfer to that specific college.
  - b. Each college sets their own transfer policy.
  - c. Once final grades are posted, each student would have to complete an online order to purchase an official CCU transcript to be sent to their college of interest.
3. How would I earn these three college credits from Colorado Christian University?
  - a. Each student would have to complete CCU's online registration and make a \$200 credit card payment for the Lead THE Cause event they are attending.
  - b. Once enrolled, each student would be emailed the YTM 197 Syllabus for Lead THE Cause: Evangelism Training that would need to be completed within 30 days of the last day of the event they attended.
4. What are the Cognitive Objectives of this YTM 197 Course?
  - a. Identify specific Biblical prayer models
  - b. Reflect upon service learning components in the practice of evangelism
  - c. Explain key ideas on evangelism and discipleship based on assigned reading
  - d. Discuss specific Biblical models of leadership
  - e. Articulate a vision and plan for implementing new evangelism strategies in a local school context
5. What are the course requirements to earn these college credits?
  - a. Attendance at Lead THE Cause. Full attendance at all sessions is required for full attendance points.
  - b. Completion of a reading guide based on assigned on-line readings totaling 375 pages.
  - c. Daily journal prompts will facilitate student reflection on the key ideas, applications, and experiences of each day.
  - d. Case studies designed to stretch student application and reflection will be completed on a daily basis.
  - e. 8 hours of onsite service learning projects and debrief.
  - f. Selection/identification of a person's "Cause Crew".
  - g. Completion of a written vision and action plan for new/revised student evangelism/discipleship strategies at the student's school in the coming year. The "Get MULTIP-L-I-E-D STRATEGY" sheet may be substituted for a paper.
  - h. Completion of a post event reflection paper at least 5 pages in length, typed, double spaced, and written in a recognized format (APA, Chicago, MLA, etc.) The paper should include key lessons learned, reflections on the service learning projects, specific points of personal spiritual growth, and key ideas from the assigned reading. The paper is due by midnight the 30th day following the completion of your event.
  - i. Any assignment turned in late may result in the loss of up to 5% of the assignments point total for every day the assignment is not turned in.
