

THE CLIFF: A Dramatic Story of Rescue **Discussion Questions**

If you want to play it with your whole youth group and process together, below are some questions to guide your discussion. Before you play the video, be sure to remind your students that this is a serious topic, so you want them to watch closely and allow the Spirit of God to work in them as they do.

1. What stood out to you most or what do you think is the main point of the video?
2. In what ways do you see your peers “getting in line for the cliff”?
3. There are three main types of characters in this drama: those who are denying, those who are trying, and those who are dying. Those who are *denying* are like the people in the church who refuse to hear the screams. In what ways might your thoughts and actions be denying the “screams” (the hurt, struggle, and pain) of your friends?
4. Those who are *trying* are like the main character and the handful of people who were willing to do whatever they could to help. As it says in Jude 23 (NIV 1984): “*snatch others from the fire and save them.*” Are there any specific friends or groups of people you want to start praying for and caring for? If so, who are they?
5. Those who are *dying* are like the ones standing in line and blindly dropping over the cliff. Some of you here are wondering if you’re in that line, or maybe even how to get out of it. Perhaps God brought you here today to be rescued from that destruction, not by anyone tackling you, but by this simple message:

God created us to be with Him.

Our sins separate us from God.

Sins cannot be removed by good deeds.

Paying the price for sin, Jesus died and rose again.

Everyone who trusts in Him alone has eternal life.

Life with Jesus starts now and lasts forever.

If you'd like to trust in Him tonight/today, let God know you're putting your faith in Jesus, and then let one of our leaders know after we're done with this discussion, and we'd be happy to help you on the next steps of your faith journey.

If you've ever put your faith in Jesus, what would be your specific next step in sharing this life-giving Gospel message with your friends?
