This year's global day of youth evangelism, Dare 2 Share LIVE, kicks off November 9.

Thousands of youth ministries around the world will be inspired, equipped and unleashed to share the Gospel with their communities.

Arvada, CO— Now in its eighth year, the Dare 2 Share LIVE event, from non-profit organization Dare 2 Share, is anticipated to have the broadest reach yet. Fully contextualized in English, Spanish, and Portuguese, this global day of youth evangelism will inspire and unleash tens of thousands of teenagers around the world into their communities to serve and to share the good news of Jesus. One of the participants, youth ministry leader, Eric Groezinger, stated, “doing Dare 2 Share LIVE has kept evangelism as a primary focus in our ministry. It isn't the only way we make this a focus, but it's a different approach that rallies our group and other groups in our community together. It has changed our ministry culture and continually reminds students that this is what we are called to do as Christians.”

Starting on November 9, 2024, youth around the world will be activated to pray, serve others, and share their faith. Inspired and trained through creative video content, attendees then go out and serve their local communities, sharing the Gospel with their friends and neighbors. The impact will spread as young people are inspired and take the Gospel to their world.

Over the past 33 years, Dare 2 Share has inspired and equipped millions of Christian teenagers and youth leaders to engage in spiritual conversations through conferences, training curriculum and resources. Through the Dare 2 Share LIVE training event, Dare 2 Share is mobilizing a youth-led evangelism movement that will activate students with the mission Jesus gave His people, to reach their generation for Christ.

Dare 2 Share Founder, Greg Stier, shares, “I'm fully convinced that one of the challenges with the typical youth conference is the absence of activation. Generation Z are not analyzers as much as they are activators. This is an experiential generation that wants to put feet to their faith and add mission to their meetings, and that's exactly what happens at Dare 2 Share LIVE: teenagers are activated to pray, care and share!”

This is the beginning of a global movement with local impact as communities are changed by the Gospel and teens are transformed as they share their faith.

About Dare 2 Share

Dare 2 Share (D2S) is a non-profit evangelistic ministry based in Wheat Ridge, Colorado. D2S was founded by Greg Stier in 1991 with the goal of training and mobilizing America's teenagers to reach their friends for Christ. When the tragic Columbine High School shooting happened just minutes from Dare 2 Share's offices in 1999, the mission of reaching teenagers with the life-changing hope of the gospel became even more urgent. That same year, Greg Stier resigned from a pastorate at a local church to focus his full efforts on the cause of D2S. For the last 33 years, God has used D2S to transform, train and equip millions of teenagers and their youth leaders across the world to share their faith in Jesus. Today, D2S offers a global video-based training event, weeklong summer evangelism and discipleship intensives, books, curriculum, youth leader trainings, and more to realize the vision of every teen, everywhere, hearing the Gospel from a friend.
