Six Languages, One Mission: Dare 2 Share's Day of Global Youth Evangelism Launches November 14.

Arvada, CO — At a time when headlines often focus on the challenges facing the next generation and the divisions shaping our world, a different story is unfolding. On November 14, 2026, youth ministries across the globe will unite for the Day of Global Youth Evangelism, a movement that equips and mobilizes teenagers to pray, serve, and share the hope of Jesus in their schools, neighborhoods, and communities.

This is not just another youth rally; it's a global movement with measurable impact. Since 2017, the event, formerly known as Dare 2 Share LIVE, has mobilized over 491,058 teens to share the Gospel, and engaged 110 countries.

Centered on the theme **ACTIVATE** this year's event challenges students to put their faith into motion. Through practical training and real-world outreach opportunities, teenagers will be empowered to take the next step in sharing the hope of Jesus with their friends.

"This generation of youth is desperate for the hope only found in the Gospel, and their peers are the best possible messengers of that hope" said Gustavo Gonzalez, Vice President of Ministry Advancement. Dare 2 Share's vision is simple: every teen, everywhere, hearing the Gospel from a friend.

For the first time, the Day of Global Youth Evangelism will equip youth leaders and students in six languages: English, Spanish, French, Portuguese, Arabic, and Hindi. This expanded reach makes it possible for ministries around the world to participate, with free, on-demand training videos and resources designed to adjust to local cultures, communities, and time zones. Youth groups will spend the morning learning and then put their training into action that same day through community service and Gospel conversations.

"The winds of revival are in the air," said Greg Stier, founder of Dare 2 Share. "Many teens are fired up, and many are asking, 'What do we do?' I want to put something in their hands they can act on. It's time to mobilize and to Gospelize."

From North and South America to Europe, Africa, the Middle East, and Asia, youth leaders can access free training that equips teenagers to prayerfully and confidently share the message of Jesus with their peers, creating impact that reaches far beyond a single day.
